


	Description	Event 1 : The national conference ASCON was organized by ASCO supported by entire OCULUS team from 22 <sup>nd</sup> June to 25 <sup>th</sup> June 2019 at Chitkara University, Chandigarh, India. Total of 475 practitioners, educators and optometry students participated in the conference. The conference covered global overview of optometry education, updates on trends in optometry education. Workshops for EBP and pedagogy techniques were delivered for appropriate target groups. Workshop on EBP was attended by 53 participants over two days. And workshop for different pedagogy and clinical assessment techniques was attended by 59 participants over two days. Feedback was taken from participating educators.  Event 2 : The national conference in Israel, organized by ICO, supported by entire OCULUS team on 16 <sup>th</sup> Sept 2019 at BIU, Tel Aviv. Total of 214 practitioners, educators and optometry students participated in the conference. The conference covered global overview of optometry education, EBP and skill assessment techniques along with updates in various clinical/ optometry practices, delivered for appropriate target groups. Faculty from BIU and HAC who were trained in the TTT workshops will lead two different continuing education events under the supervision and mentorship of programme country members..
